

The Sycamore Fire Department is currently accepting applications for the position of firefighter. Applications are available at iosolutions.com until July 24, 2018. The application deadline is July 24, 2018 at 4:00 PM. You must meet the following minimum requirements:

- \$25.00 non-refundable application fee;
- U.S. Citizen or legally authorized to work in the U.S. (Must meet I-9 requirements);
- High School Diploma or Equivalent;
- Valid Driver's License (valid Illinois Driver's License at time of hire);
- 21 to under 35 years of age at time of application deadline, unless otherwise exempt by statute. (Applicants can be 20 years of age if they are currently participating in the Sycamore college internship program);
- Proof of completion of Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) and Ladder Climb Test within 12 months prior to the date of application deadline (7/24/18). CPAT/Ladder Climb accepted from:
 - Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy (NIPSTA) – www.nipsta.org
 - Southwest United Fire Districts (SUFD) – www.sufd.org
 - Any certifying agency possessing a Limited License by the IAFF/IAFC Wellness-Fitness Initiative
- Certified Illinois Office of State Fire Marshal Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter at time of application deadline;
- Licensed Illinois Department of Public Health Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic (IDPH EMT-P) at time of application deadline;
- Must reside within the distance of the City of Sycamore that complies with the Sycamore Municipal Code, the City's Personnel Policies, or applicable collective bargaining agreements.

All portions of the testing process are mandatory. Failure to attend and complete any portion of the process will result in elimination from employment consideration.

Written Exam/Orientation Information:

Candidates must attend the mandatory orientation and written examination on **Saturday, August 18, 2018**. Doors to the testing site will open at 7:00 a.m. Sign-in begins at 7:00 a.m. **Please arrive no later than 7:30 a.m.** with a photo ID (driver's license, state ID, military ID) to sign-in. The doors will be closed at 7:30 a.m. **No late arrivals will be permitted to enter.** Testing will take place in Sycamore, IL. The exact testing location will be provided to eligible candidates prior to the exam date.
