

**From City of Sycamore City Council Minutes
Dated December 11, 1905**

“Be it resolved by the Mayor & City Council of Sycamore, Ill, being duly assembled,

That we recognize the evils existing in public life arising from the unlawful use of money or special privileges to attain private or corporate gain at the expense of the public,

That we are opposed to “graft” thereby meaning bribery or receiving or soliciting a bribe in every form,

Further that we should insist on the resignation or expulsion of any member of this body found guilty of soliciting or receiving a bribe for the purpose of influencing his vote on any measure coming before this Council,

Dated Sycamore Ill Dec 11, '05,

Moved by Ald Stark, seconded by Ald Hollenbeck, that the resolution as read be the sense of the Council.

Motion carried. “All for.”
