



Laborer, Wastewater Treatment Plant Division, City of Sycamore

The City of Sycamore is seeking a Laborer within the Public Works Department, WWTP Division. This position reports directly to the Superintendent of Public Works, WWTP. This position is created and governed by City Code and City policies and shall comply with Federal, State and Local rules and regulations governing the position.

This is a full-time position assigned to the Street Division. The position of Laborer, WWTP Division performs skilled, semi-skilled and general manual labor work on the street, sewer lines, street signs, buildings, forestry control and other street related maintenance work and other related duties, as assigned.

Minimum qualifications required:

Education:

- High School graduation or equivalent is required.

Experience:

- Experience in the wastewater treatment field and sanitary collection system or other experiences associated with Public Works.
- **Certification And Licenses Required:**
 - Any level of Wastewater Certification from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency within 12 months of hire.
 - Possession of a valid CDL Class B State of Illinois Vehicle Operator's license within 30 days of hire.
 - National Incident Management System (NIMS) Training. Courses: ICS 100 and ICS 700.

This is non-exempt, AFSCME Local 3957, full-time position that requires a normal 40-hour workweek. The starting annual salary is \$52,290. The City of Sycamore offers a generous benefit package. Candidates must meet the 20-mile residency requirement.
