The City of Sycamore is seeking experienced and Illinois Certified Police Officers for an eligibility list for lateral entry.

Qualifications

- Permanent, legal resident of the United States.
- Must be a certified Police Officer (Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board).
- Actively employed by law enforcement agency for at least 2 years and within the last 12 months.
- Binocular vision correctable to 20/20.
- Valid Illinois Drivers license.
- High School diploma or equivalent and 60 hours of college coursework.
- Physical Fitness Certification
- Ability to meet job related physical requirements.
- Residency within 20 miles of the DeKalb County Courthouse by end of probation.



Benefits

- Starting Salary \$57,541.77 (Step 2).
- Rotating 12 hour shift schedule.
- Comprehensive Labor Contract between City of Sycamore and F.O.P. Lodge.
- Excellent health, dental, vision, and life insurance benefits.

Selection Process

1. Initial screening based on application review and credential verification.
2. Oral Interview by panel consisting of the Fire and Police Commissioners and members of the Police Department.
3. Background investigation by department investigators (includes polygraph).
4. Medical examination and psychological evaluation upon conditional offer of employment.
