
Construction Notice

2023 Watermain and Street Improvements

Copenhaver Construction Inc. is scheduled to begin work on **DeKalb Avenue and Elm Street (between Center Cross and Main Street) as early as Monday April 3rd**. This project will be divided into two phases, which are indicated on the attached sheet.

Timeline

Phase 1- April to June Watermain Improvements – Between Center Cross and Somonauk Street
Phase 2 – July to October Roadway/Sidewalk Improvements – Between Center Cross & Main Street

Scope of Work – Phase 1 - Watermain

- Watermain and Service Replacements
- Temporary Patching of Roadway
- Landscape (grass) restoration

Water Service

- The City will provide advance written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or service interruptions
 - Residents - 48 Hours Notice
 - Businesses – 1 Week Notice

Access and Parking

- **Special Events:** The City is coordinating all special events with the applicant and contractor.
- **DeKalb Avenue and Elm Street:** These are anticipated to remain open with periodic lane closures
- **Side Streets:** Temporary Closures of side streets will be required.
- **Residential Driveways:** You may temporarily not have access to your driveway during concrete work. Contractor will provide advance warning and knock on your door.

General Notes

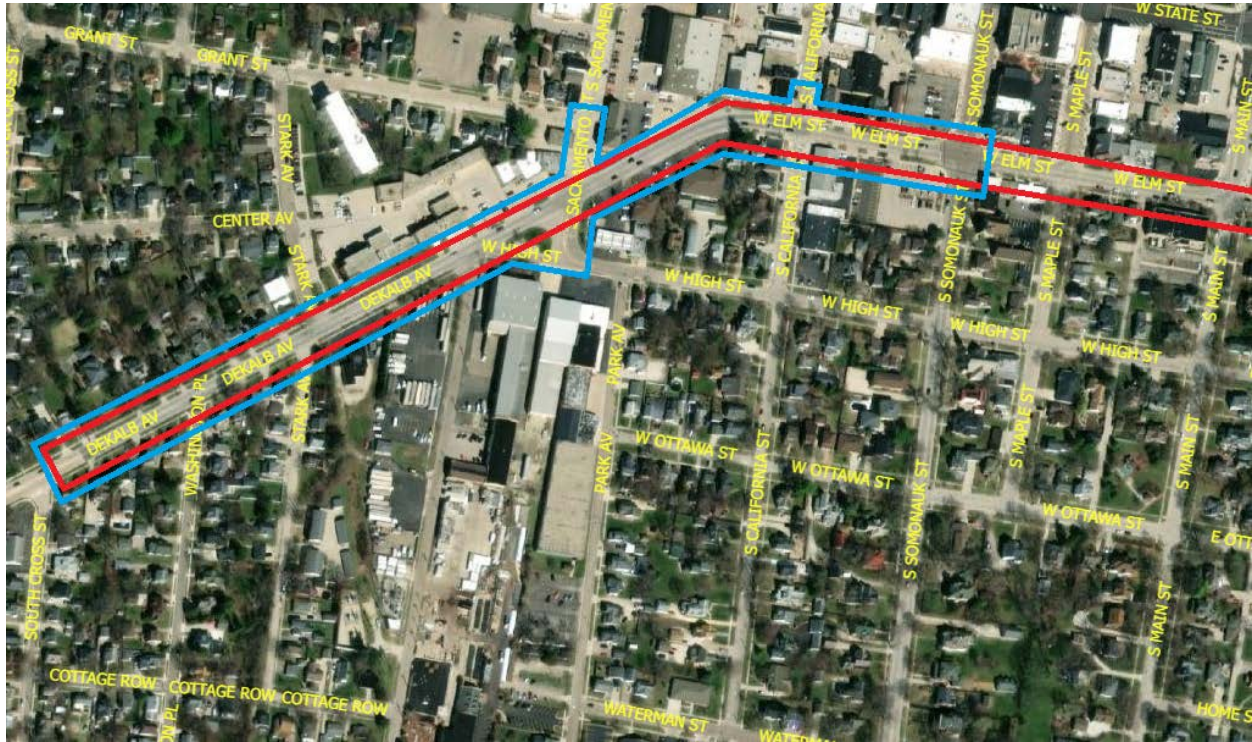
- Emergency vehicles will always have access during this construction project.
- Signs will be posted by Contractor, as applicable, (Fresh Oil, No Parking, Road Construction Ahead, etc.) during the construction and may provide further updates on the construction progress to the adjoining residents and others.

Refuse and Recycling Pick up

- Waste Management will continue normal pick-up of refuse, recycle and landscape materials.
