RED WREATH PROGRAM REPORT

Holiday wreaths remain red this season

Sycamore, IL. January 2, 2020—During the holiday season beginning on Thanksgiving Day, November 28, 2019, and ending after New Year’s Day on January 2, 2020, the Sycamore Fire Department displays a red wreath on each station to signify the number of holiday-related fire responses taking place during that time period.

We are pleased to announce that for the first time in three years, the Sycamore Fire Department did not respond to any holiday-related fire incidents. We would like to commend our Sycamore residents for their attention to holiday safety, and encourage our citizens to remain safety conscious throughout the New Year.

Though the Sycamore Fire Department did not respond to any holiday-related fires during the Red Wreath Program, there were **235 requests for emergency service**. Of those requests, 181 were for emergency medical services responses, 22 motor vehicle accident responses and 32 non-holiday fire related responses.
