The Sycamore Police Department consists of 31 sworn officers among two divisions, Operations and Support Services. Authorized staffing includes: a Chief of Police, 2 Deputy Chiefs, 6 sergeants, 17 patrol officers, 2 detectives, 1 drug/intel detective and 2 School Resource Officers. In 2020, Sycamore PD logged 21,843 incidents including 8,033 calls for service. Sycamore is approximately 10 square miles and located 60 miles west of Chicago and 30 miles south of Rockford.

Minimum Requirements

- Must establish residency within 20 miles of 100 North Main, Sycamore within one (1) year of the conclusion of probation;
- Must be of excellent moral character and personal integrity;
- Any other rules and regulations as prescribed by the City of Sycamore Board of Police and Fire Commissioners.

- Test must be submitted between May 15 and June 15, 2022.
